The process of expulsion shall be communicated to every member. Every such expelled member shall have a right to appeal before the general body which may or may not be accepted.


Right and Privilege of membership :- Every member has right to inspect the minutes of the society and privilege to participate in its meetings programmes etc.

6. General Body :- There shall be a general body of the society consisting of all the members. Meetings of the general body shall be held after every one year with 10 days notice and with 1/3 quorum. No quorum shall be required in the adjourned meeting. An emergent meeting of the general body may also be summoned on the written request of 3/5 members. Following business shall be transacted in these meetings:-

- i. To prepare annual programmes and policies.
- ii. To pass annual budget of the society.
- iii. To discuss and to decide all such other matters and issues which are directly or indirectly related to the affairs of the society.
- iv. To appoint an auditor who will annually inspect the accounts of the society's funds.

7. Governing Body :- There shall be a governing body of the society to look after and to manage the day to day affairs of the society. It shall consist of minimum 7 and maximum 15 members including the office bearers. With 10 days notice meetings of the governing body shall be after every one month with 1/3 quorum. No quorum shall be required in the adjourned meeting. An emergent meeting of the governing body may also be summoned on the written request of 3/5 members.
